Also some policy recommendations have been drafted under the framework of the Intellectual Output 4 in order to improve policies on employment orientation for adults. Finally each partner has organised in September a national multiplier event for dissemination of the results and project impact.

4th Meeting in Sheffield, UK

The fourth transnational meeting of the QUALIFY project took place in Sheffield, UK from July 2 to 3, 2019. Several project management issues and dissemination were discussed. Also, the next steps and deadlines were set in order to finalize the project. 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I03 - Implementation of modern ICT Tools to support career management for low-skilled adults Training

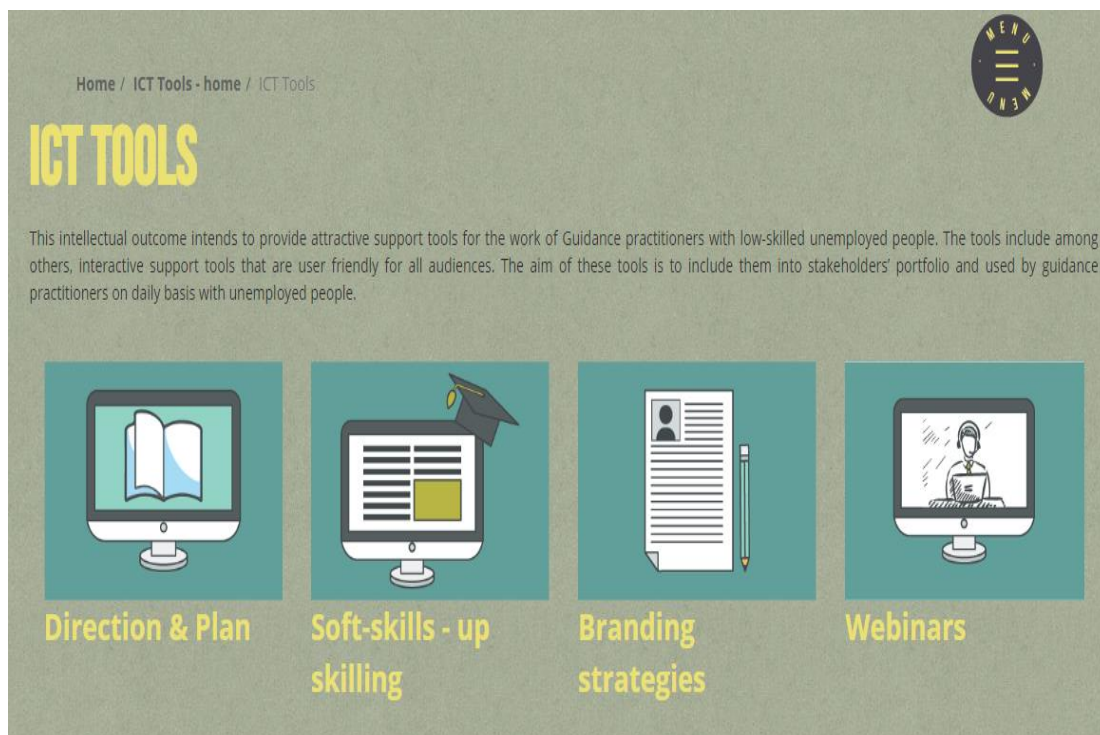
This intellectual output intends to be an attractive support tool for the work of guidance practitioners working with low-skilled unemployed adults. The different tools that have been developed are, user friendly interactive support tools for all audiences. The aim of these tools is to include them into stakeholders' portfolios to be used by guidance practitioners on a daily basis with unemployed people.

Tool 1: Direction and Plan. It has a format of an e-book and it aims to develop a clear strategy for supporting low-skilled unemployed.

Tool 2: Soft Skills and Upskilling, which explores communication skills, professionalism, time management and having a positive mind set. This tool gives additional support to career professionals and ideas for working with their unemployed clients.

Tool 3: Branding strategies. This tool provides useful tips to prepare a client and increase their chances of landing a job in a very friendly and really dynamic way!

All the tools are free to use and are available on the project website. Different webinars have been recorded and can be accessed on the project website. This will help the user to understand how to use the tools.



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IO4 - Recommendations to policy makers on new strategies to support effective career guidance to low-skilled unemployed adults
