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1 INTRODUCTION TO THE PROJECT


T-shirt is an international project co-funded by the European Union Erasmus+ Programme. It is coordinated by Casa do Professor and the project brings together 7 organisations from 5 European countries (Portugal, Greece, Cyprus, the United Kingdom and Romania).



In the first 12 months of the project, the consortium developed the T-SHIRT COURSES FOR TEACHERS that aim to equip teachers with updated knowledge and skills on gender equality and self-assessment tools that they can use to reflect on their practices and the new methods proposed in the course. The modules developed consider the following issues:

- International, European and national policies for gender equality;
- Feminist research about education and gender;
- Biological and social gender - gender identities and discrimination;
- The role of gender stereotypes in society;
- Education and gender inequalities: the composition of the population of teachers according to gender;
- Teachers and gender: assumptions, expectations and practices;
- The role of teachers in the deconstruction of gender stereotypes.

T-SHIRT GUIDE & METHODOLOGY PACKAGE

Teachers will be empowered through a structured capacity building guide and will be provided with specific techniques, strategies, checklists, and classroom protocols, in parallel with techniques and practices on developing gender equality schemes within the classroom climate and atmosphere.

T-SHIRT DIGITAL RESOURCES AND TOOLS

Teachers will be provided with digital resources, such as games and video collections, that they can use as complementary tools in their teaching practices, and an eLearning platform which will be used both as a virtual learning environment for teachers and as a means of disseminating the project.
